

Worksheet W: Sharing Your Work

In your pairs, share your photographs with your partners. One of you will act as the artist, the other as the critic. The critic asks the artist about his or her work. Then you switch roles.

This is a chance for you to learn about one another's work and offer each other helpful feedback.

Here are some sample questions the critic can ask the artist:

1. Do you have a title for your artwork? What is it?
2. What message are you trying to convey in this work?
3. What kind of emotion would you like your audience to feel when they look at it?
4. What inspired you to make this piece, besides the fact that it was an assignment?
